

The local wheat production is not sufficient for domestic requirements and South Africa has to import approximately half of the wheat required for its domestic consumption needs. During the 2012/2013 season 1.396 million tons of wheat were imported for domestic consumption and so far 1.308 million tons of wheat have been imported for the current season.
